

# **VOLUSIA COUNTY GUN & HUNT CLUB**

## **OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES**

1. Membership cards must be carried at all times while on Club property. (Do not lend your card or give out the Combination to anyone, they will be committing armed trespass).
2. Members are required to provide photo ID at the time they sign in with the Range Officer. There are no Exceptions.
3. Shooting hours are 9:00 a.m. until posted closing time. Closing times will be posted at the front gate and enforced by the Range Officer on duty.
4. Only TWO guests per member per visit (You are responsible for everything your guests do and have to be with them while they are shooting). Guests must fill out and sign a liability waiver/parental consent and be at least 10 years old. A daily fee of \$10.00 per guest will apply.
5. Firearms may only be handled when range is HOT.
6. Changing range conditions from COLD to HOT or HOT to COLD is the SOLE responsibility of the Range Officer on Duty. Shooters are NOT to change the condition of the range without express permission of the Range Officer.
7. Firearms shall be carried with the action OPEN and UNLOADED at all times (Including to and from cars or from station to station except on action ranges). "This does not apply to concealed carry licensees, or sworn law enforcement officers of the state of Florida."
8. All shooting shall be done from the firing stations behind the firing line.
9. Shoot perpendicular to the firing line only.
10. ALL BULLETS MUST IMPACT THE DIRT BERMS - They cannot hit the ground in front of berms.
11. All target placements must allow the shooter to see the berm on every side of the target.(does not apply to action ranges)
12. Eye and Hearing Protection  
Must be used by anyone on the firing line.
13. No ALCOHOLIC Beverages or glass containers on the range.
14. No Class 3 weapons without express permission from the range officer and proper credentials. All NFA rules apply. (Doesn't apply to law enforcement training days, or those individuals who possess an NFA registered firearm)\*\*
15. Combat or Quick Draw Practice only in action range areas.
16. No shooting metal targets closer than the 7 yard line.
17. No Spinning metal target shooting above .22 caliber.
18. No Glass targets.
19. No Propane tanks.
20. No Exploding targets.
21. Shooter is responsible for replacing any property damaged by their actions.
22. Absolutely NO shooting of domestic livestock or wild game on the range.
23. Range Officers are in charge of the range at all times.
